Yukari graduated in 2016 and works for ANA Kansai Airport Co. Ltd. as a member of the ground staff team in charge of Delta Airlines, a large American airline company.

Working in the 24-hour international airport, she has ample opportunities to use her excellent command of English while assisting foreign tourists.

She talked about the role she plays with customers including announcements in English, and also about her daily, weekly, and monthly schedules.

Ayaka talked about many of the steps that she does to make sure each flight is safe; for example, the distribution of weight on the plane. She explained the importance of keeping the balance of an airplane when loading baggage and cargos using unusual pictures of loading accidents.
