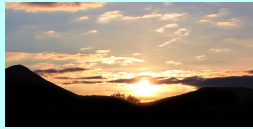


# Around The World

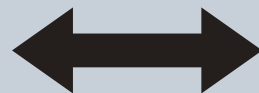

## How To Play

To play this game, each student will need a game piece (e.g. an eraser, pencil cap, USB). Students will race around the world. One student will race clockwise, and one student will race anti-clockwise.

The students should place their game piece at the bottom where it says "Start/Finish".

Students should then play "rock, paper, scissors". The winning student may then move his/her game piece one square. Students should then answer the question in that square.

Next, the students should play "rock, paper, scissors" again.

The student who moves around the world the fastest wins.
